1. General Information

- 1. Dr. YSR Architecture and Fine Arts University (Dr.YSRAFAU), Kadapa inviting applications from eligible candidates for direct admission (without Art and Design Common Entrance Test ADCET) into Bachelor of Fine Arts (Animation/Applied Arts/Painting/ Photography/Sculpture) and Bachelor of Design (Interior Design) Courses for the academic year 2025-26.
- 2. Candidates who want to apply for both Bachelor of Fine Arts and Bachelor of Design (Interior Design) have to pay prescribed fee (Opt for as specific BFA/B. Design course in the order of priority).
- 3. Candidates who have passed 10+2 or 10+3 in any group (MPC/MEC/ BIPC /MBIPC/CEC/HEC or 3 years diploma or Equivalent Course, etc.) are eligible to apply.
- 4. The minimum eligibility for admission into all courses is attaining qualifying marks (35%) and allotment of seats will be based on the merit in qualifying marks.
- 5. Considering A CANDIDATE application FOR BFA/B. Des -2024 DOES NOT GUARANTEE A RIGHT OF ADMISSION INTO THE COURSE OF STUDY. A candidate must satisfy the eligibility criteria as mentioned above. Candidates furnishing false information a reliable for prose caution and cancellation of seats without notice. The decision of the admitting authority is final.
- 6. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill the seats earmarked for a particular course on administrative reasons. All admissions are purely provisional and the concerned University reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage. Further, it also reserves the right to run or not to run a particular course depending on the number of candidates joined in it.
- 7. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTIONS IN ALL COURSES WILL BE IN ENGLISH. HENCE THE CANDIDATES SHALL WRITE THEIR SUBSEQUENT EXAMINATIONS AFTER ADMISSION. IN ENGLISH ONLY.
- 8. The Candidates are advised to refer to the Eligibility, Intake, Tuition Fee, Time Table and Rules of Reservation for admission before filling the application form.
- 9. All the entries should be correct and the candidate will be held personally responsible for any incorrect entry that he/she makes.
- 10. Any false or incorrect statement in the application detected at any stage will render the admission of the candidate null and void.
- 11. The candidates are therefore required to check the filled in particulars before pressing the SUBMIT button. No changes will be allowed after the submission button pressed.
- 12. Candidates should then take the print out of the submitted application form and receipt for future reference.
- 13. Registration fee once paid will not be refunded, even if the applications rejected either before or after the admission.
- 14. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED.

2. How to Apply

To apply for BFA/B.Des admissions at Dr. YSR Architecture and Fine Arts University, candidates must fill out the online application form carefully by providing personal, educational, and contact details, upload the required scanned documents, select course preferences, pay the application fee using the UPI QR code provided, and submit the form before the deadline after reviewing all entries for accuracy.

2.1. Course Preferences

Select and arrange any of your preferred courses from the available list (Animation, Applied Art, Interior Design, Painting, Photography, Sculpture) in order of priority from First to Fourth, as these preferences will directly influence your seat allotment during admissions. Admission in every course will be based on merit in qualifying exam. Therefore, if the candidate didn't get seat in his/her first preferred course at the time of counselling, the admitting authority will allot seat in Second/Third/Fourth preferred course depends on seat availability.

2.2. Personal Details

Enter your full name as per SSC records, along with your parents' full names, date of birth in DD/MM/YYYY format, gender, and Aadhaar number without errors, ensuring they match your official documents.

2.3. Family & Category Details

Provide your parents' annual income supported by an uploaded Income Certificate, select your applicable category (SC/ST/BC/EWS/OC), and upload valid caste or EWS certificates (less than 1 MB) if you belong to a reserved category.

2.4. Contact Details

Fill in your complete postal address (including house number, street, Mandal, district, state, and pin code), provide an active primary mobile number, an alternate number of Parent/Gaudian (if available), and a valid email ID for all future communication.

2.5. Educational Qualifications

Enter your SSC and Intermediate (10+2) details accurately, including hall ticket numbers, year of passing, school/college name, place of study, and upload clear scanned copies of your SSC and Intermediate certificates. (Less than 1 MB)

2.6. Application Fee Payment

Select your category to know the exact fee, make the payment via UPI by scanning the provided QR code, and upload the payment confirmation screenshot/receipt (less than 1 MB) along with the UTR number from your UPI app.

Applicants are required to pay the registration fee based on their category (OC, BC, SC/ST) within the specified schedule. Applications submitted after the initial deadline will incur a late fee, which increases progressively for each late submission window. The details of the category-wise registration fee and applicable late fees are provided in the table below.

Ensure all necessary documents—including SSC and Intermediate certificates, caste/EWS/income certificates (if applicable), and payment screenshot/receipt are scanned clearly and uploaded in PDF or JPEG format in Maximum 1 MB or less.

4. Eligibility Criteria, Intake and Course Fee

The university offers Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) and Bachelor of Design (B.Des) programs with specializations designed to nurture creative and technical skills. Each course requires candidates to have passed Intermediate (10+2) or an equivalent qualification, offers a four-year curriculum with an annual tuition fee and intake capacity for each specialization as specified below.

Details of the under graduate courses are as follows:

5. Admission Information:

- 1. All candidates will be awarded Ranks as per marks secured in the test appeared.
- 2. In case of a tie between candidates securing the same mark in a test, the order of merit will be decided on the basis of date of birth of the candidate with priority to older candidate.
- 3. Admission shall be based on the Rank, subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria.
- 4. The University shall not be responsible for either non-receipt or delayed receipt of communications in this regard.
- 5. The University reserves the right to deny admission If the University finds the antecedents of the candidates are bad subsequent to admit, his/her rank can be cancelled and the candidate can be denied admission into any course under Dr. YSRAFAU or admission can be cancelled even if admission is given.
- 6. The admission process will be purely based on the 'Reservation Policy" of Andhra Pradesh Government in-force.
- 7. All the admissions are purely provisional and the University reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage.
- 8. The conversion of reserved seats in to other category will not be made in the first phase of counseling.
- 9. The student has to select the course of study through online application.
- Candidates who did not claim their reservation / special category at the time of submission of their applications will also be allowed under that particular category subject to production of

- original certificates at the time of certificate verification.
- 11. Cancellation of seats: Cancellation of seats will be made with 90% refund of total fee prescribed before completion of first phase of counseling and 80% refund of the total fee prescribed before completion of second phase counselling and with no fee refund after second phase of counseling.
- 12. Candidates should produce original certificates for verification after the provisional allotment, at the offices of the principal concerned (All the certificates will be returned except TC)

'Rules of Reservation' for admission in to Under- Graduate Courses

- 1. The allocation of reservation seats percentage detailed below is as per G.O.M.S.No.184, Education (EC-2) 8 Department, dt. 20-8-1993, and G.O.M.S.No.116 SW (CV-1) dt. 10-12-1999 as amended up-to-date.
- 2. Among the seats sanction edit each course, 85% of the seats are given to reserved categories of local
- 3. (L) Candidates who belongs all 26 districts of Andhra Pradesh while 15% of the seats are given to local and non-local candidates (L/NL) on merit.
- 4. The 85% reserved seats are filled by local candidates belonging to total 26 Districts of Andhra Pradesh.

a) Schedule Caste (SC) : 15% b) Schedule Tribe (ST) : 6%

c) Backward Communities (BC) : 29% (A-7%, B-10%, C-1%, BD-7%, E -4%)

Other Category Reservations:

d) Differently able : 3% e) CAP (Children of Armed Persons) : 2% f) NCC/ECA : 1.5% g) Sports : 0.5%

h) Woman : 33.3% (over all in each category)

i) EWS (Economically Weaker Section

In OC Category) : 10% over and above sanctioned intake

- 5. At any cost the total number of candidates admitted under non-local category should not exceed 15% putting together in all categories of OC, SC, ST, BC, ECA, CAP and PH. However, filling up of 15% of seats with non-local candidates is not a must in case of non-availability of such candidates. The University scrupulously follows the reservations in accordance with GOI Policy and the guidelines of the UGC from time to time.
- 6. If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Class of a particular group are not available, the left-over seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left-over seats shall be treated as unreserved and shall be filled up with candidates of General Pool. No candidates seeking reservation for admission under above categories be allowed to participate,

- in the Counseling for admission unless he/she produces the Integrated Community Certificated prescribed by the Govt. and issued by the Revenue Authorities in the Government (vide G.O. MS. No: 58, Social Welfare (J), Dept., Dated:12-5-1997).
- 7. A maximum of 10% of the total seats over and above sanctioned intake in each course (Regular/Self Finance) is available under Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) category (as per G. O. Ms No: 39, Dt:30-07-2019) for the candidates who are not covered under existing scheme of reservations.
- 8. For admission into Extracurricular Activities (ECA) seats, participation during the period of study of the qualifying examination is alone considered. The priorities in respect of the special categories mentioned above shall be in accordance with Government Orders issued from time to time.
- 9. Expert committees nominated by the University will certify the suitability and priority of the candidates under special categories (ECA/PH/CAP) by following the up-to-date guidelines.
- 10. Reservation for women: One third of the seats are reserved for women candidates in each category (i.e., OC, SC, ST, BC, ECA, PH and L/NL). This rule is not applied if women candidates selected on merit in a category from one third or more of the seats therein. If there are no suitable women candidates in a category, the seats will be directed to the men candidates of the same category. Absence of adequate number of women candidates in a category cannot be compensated by giving more seats for women in another category.
- 11. The details of tuition fee per annum to be paid at the time of admission for various BFA and B. Design courses are given in the above table. Candidates who are eligible for fee reimbursement under SC/ST category whose parents' annual income is less than Rs.2,00,000/- and for BC/OC candidates whose parents' annual income is less than Rs.1,00,000/- holding an income certificate eligible for fee reimbursement from the Government of Andhra Pradesh. All other candidates admitted under regular admissions should pay the stipulated tuition fee as specified by the University.
- 12. In case if government does not reimburse the equivalent fee as specified, the candidate has to pay the balance tuition fee to the University. Those submitting Income certificate of parent must bring an attested copy from Tahsildar of respective locations in the year 2025.
- 13. If the seat allotted to a candidate is cancelled for any valid reasons before the closure of the admissions, the tuition fee paid by the candidate will be refunded after deducting 10% of the tuition fee prescribed for that course. In case if a candidate wants to cancel the seat after the closure of the admissions, the candidate is required to pay the fee as per the norms of the University in order to receive back his/her certificates. A separate Transfer Certificate will be issued to such candidates.
